Attended Altrincham Grammar School. A keen tennis, table tennis and badminton player.

Employed at Lloyds Bank in Altrincham.

He had two brothers also on active service - one in the Army, the other in the RAF.

Death reported in the 17 April 1942 edition of the Sale & Stretford Guardian.

Commemorated on the private family gravestone in Hale Cemetery, which refers to him as Douglas.

His father, James died 7 November 1938 aged 61 years and his mother, Anna Jeanette died 8 December 1960 aged 81 years.
